Dear Neighborhood Club Program Participants and Members:

We will continue to follow the guidance issued by Governor Gretchen Whitmer and Executive Orders, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, as well as national officials and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the World Health Organization.

Based on the Governor's Executive Order 2020-20 that includes Recreation Centers and Fitness Centers, the Neighborhood Club must extend our closure through at least until Monday, April 13, 2020 or until further notice. This also coincides with Executive Order 2020-21 that states for everyone to Stay-At-Home through April 13, 2020. Our closures include the Recreation and Wellness Center, including preschool, and the Thrift Shop.

We believe it is our social responsibility and core to our mission to help reduce health risks to our patrons, guests and our staff. We will continue to reassess the situation in the coming days and weeks. Decisions regarding reopening the building and rescheduling events will be made pending recommendations from state and local governments and announced as soon as possible.

- **Members of the Fitness Facility** – Based on your billing date, we will begin to credit all recurring memberships for the month of April, therefore, you will not be charged for at least one full month of service. If the mandated closure lasts longer than one month, we will credit you for the time the facility was closed when we resume operations. Please note that some instructors are posting workouts on social media and YouTube for your convenience. THANK YOU fitness instructors!
- **Program Participants and Classes** – Those programs that have been cancelled, our customers will receive a full credit to their account. Other programs will receive a prorated credit to their account. All credits will take place upon our resume of operations.

Most important, individuals are advised to stay home if they become sick. Limit your contact with others and seek medical treatment if your symptoms persist or become more serious.

We're all in this together; together we will get through this! We wish everyone to stay safe and healthy. Additional updates will be communicated via email, Facebook, Twitter, Eblasts, and in local press whenever possible.
