Dear Neighborhood Club Program Participants and Members:

We are pleased to announce that we plan to resume operations and welcome you back to our facility and our programs on Thursday, June 25, pending the decision on the Governor's appeal.

Our hours at the Recreation and Wellness Center will be:

Monday-Thursday: 5 am – 9 pm

Friday: 5 am – 8 pm

Saturday: 7 am – 5 pm

Sunday: 8 am – 4 pm

The Neighborhood Club has adjusted to comply with CDC and state guidelines regarding social distancing and we have enhanced our already high standards for cleanliness for your increased safety and comfort!

PLEASE NOTE: Initially we will open only for members and monthly pass holders. Guest passes and day pass sales are currently suspended.

Members of the Fitness Facility –

Following our closure in March, we did not charge recurring members for the months of April, May, and June. We will resume charging your account on your billing date beginning July 1. If you are not quite ready to return at this time as a recurring member, please email katie@neighborhoodclub.org if you wish to place your account on a temporary freeze (\$10 per month).

Please note that at this time we modified the layout of fitness equipment in the Recreation and Wellness Center to comply with social distancing and CDC guidelines. Group exercise classes will resume indoors on July 1; until then some classes will continue to be offered outdoors and on social media.

Currently the aquatic center has not been approved to open, but we hope that we will be able to resume operations in the aquatic center soon.
