Dear Neighborhood Club Program Participants and Members:

We will continue to follow the guidance issued by Governor Gretchen Whitmer and Executive Orders, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, as well as national officials and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the World Health Organization.

**Based on the Governor's Executive Orders that includes Recreation Centers and Fitness Centers, the Neighborhood Club must extend our closure through at least until April 30, 2020 or until further notice. Our closures include the Recreation and Wellness Center and the Thrift Shop.**

We will continue to reassess the situation in the coming days and weeks. Decisions regarding reopening the building and rescheduling events will be made pending recommendations from state and local governments and announced as soon as possible.

**Members of the Fitness Facility** – Based on your billing date, we will credit all recurring memberships for the month of April and May, therefore, you will not be charged for at least two full months of service. If the mandated closure lasts longer, we will credit you for the time the facility was closed when we resume operations. Please note that some instructors are posting workouts on social media and YouTube for your convenience. THANK YOU fitness instructors!

**Program Participants and Classes** –

**Postponed Programs:** Swim lessons, lifeguard classes, field hockey clinics, indoor rowing, adaptive rowing, indoor triathlon, strength training for athletes, fall proof balance and mobility training, self-defense training for women, adult softball, men's basketball, youth soccer, youth lacrosse, youth tee-ball.

**Cancelled Programs:** Preschool (remainder of term), dog obedience, pottery, computer classes, National Fitness Day, karate for kids/families/teens, co-rec volleyball intermediate and recreational, women's volleyball league (remainder of season).

Those programs that have been cancelled, our customers will receive an account credit or a refund. Other programs will receive a prorated account credit/refund to their account.

Most important, individuals are advised to stay home if they become sick. Limit your contact with others and seek medical treatment if your symptoms persist or become more serious.
