Dear Neighborhood Club Program Participants and Members:

We are anxious to resume operations and welcome you back to our facility and our programs. Opening updates will be communicated via our website, Facebook, Twitter, Eblasts, and in local press. We continue to follow the guidelines for the state of Michigan issued by Governor Whitmer as well as recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

I am pleased to announce that our Thrift Shop will open to the public in the near future by appointment only. Once we reopen, shopping appointments can be made by calling 313.757.2234 during shop business hours. We will follow all social distancing guidelines including all must wear a mask and we will limit customers and donors in the store at all times. We will conduct frequent cleanings throughout the day. Donations of items to the Thrift Shop will be accepted only on Saturdays at first and only by appointment once the store resumes operations. See our Facebook and social media pages for updates.

Based on the most recent Governor's Executive Order that includes recreation centers and fitness centers, the Neighborhood Club Recreation and Wellness Center must extend our closure through at least until June 12, 2020. We are preparing to reopen the Recreation and Wellness Center as soon as possible once the Governor amends her Executive Orders for recreation centers/fitness centers. The Neighborhood Club has adjusted to comply with CDC and state guidelines regarding social distancing and we have enhanced our already high standards for cleanliness for your increased safety and comfort!

Members of the Fitness Facility – Based on your billing date, we will credit all recurring memberships for the month of April, May, and now June. Therefore, you will not be charged for at least three full months of service. If the mandated closure for fitness centers lasts longer, we will credit you for the time the facility was closed. We are grateful to our fitness instructors for posting workouts on social media and YouTube to help keep you healthy and active!

Program Participants and Classes – Regarding programs that were cancelled, registrants will receive a full account credit or refund. Other program participants will receive a prorated account credit/refund.
